## **RBSC Trail Report**

To date we have cleared 30 km of trails with our new cutter . The cleared trails are anywhere from 12 to 20 feet wide and completely free of willows. Some of our main trails could not yet be accessed because of wet conditions. The total cost for clearing trails averages out to approximately \$100/km. We have a trail clearing budget of \$5000 for this year and have approximately \$2000 remaining which will first be used to clear the Kids Lake Trail. We have also received donations for clearing particular trails. This will not be reflected in our trail clearing budget. Anyone who is interested in donating for clearing a particular trail is most welcome to do so. As mentioned earlier, \$100 clears 1km.

### Trails Cleared as of Nov 13/11

- Ramp Trail
- Trail from the Elaine Lake Road to Musquash shelter
- 2 km of the Kids Lake trail from the West
- Most of the MacLennan Lake Trail
- Halfway House Trail except for a 1.5 km portion near Uytterhagen Lake
- George Lake Trail South from the Wanner Lake Road
- Trail from Gene Lake to the Wanner Lake Road
- Trail from the Elaine Lake Road to Home Hay Lake
- Portion of the Pratt Lake Trail towards Cheeyas.

We have also cleared, at no cost to the club (a donation by Gerry Schultz) a new trail from the Elaine Lake Road to Schultz Lake. Further donations have been received for continuing the clearing of this trail to Tourist Lake.

### Other trail maintenance items:

- Installed a culvert at the creek on the Kids Lake Trail
- Removed a portion of the berm on the Kids Lake trail to enable grooming and better access.
- Leveled the North entrance to the Halfway House Trail near the gravel pit.
- Re-bermed the entrance near Musquash to eliminate truck traffic.
- Cleared fallen trees and cleaned up at the Musquash shelter.
